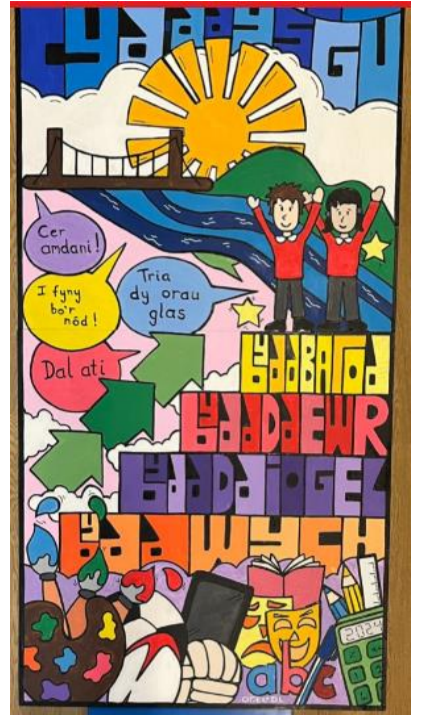




Keeping safe, happy and healthy

What is Safeguarding?

At Ysgol Parcyrhun we believe that safeguarding is keeping **everyone safe**. All the adults around you think that your health, safety, and happiness are very important. We teach you to recognise risks in different situations, and how to protect yourselves and stay safe.

- Making you say or do things that make you feel uncomfortable.
- Giving you money or gifts if you do something for them.
