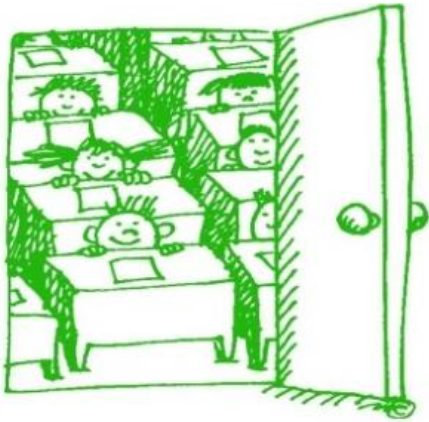

Addysg Gorfforol / Physical Education :

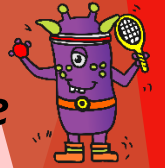

Building healthy habits**



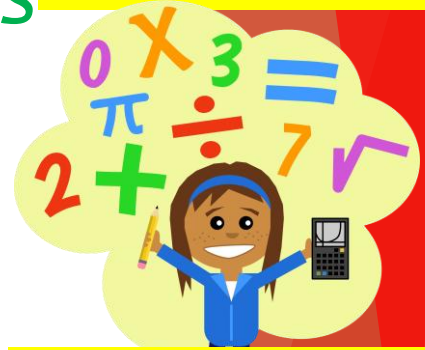

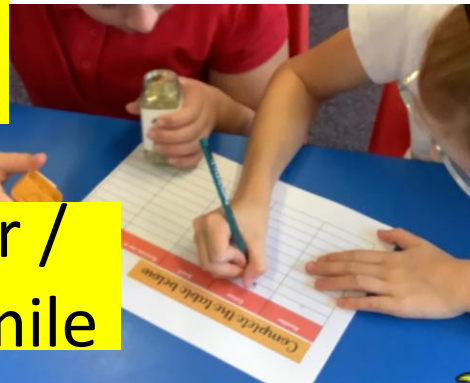

What is Hwb?

All children are provided with personal Hwb log in details once an acceptable use policy has been signed by both the pupil and the parents.

All of the children are encouraged to log into their Hwb+ accounts using the equipment available in the classroom.

All pupils and staff have access to Welsh Government's Hwb portal. In addition to a wealth of learning resources, Hwb users also have full Microsoft Office 365 functionality which includes online versions of Word, PowerPoint, Excel and OneNote. Attendance and Punctuality

Regular attendance and punctuality are important if children are to take part fully in the life of the school and to take advantage of the learning opportunities offered by the school. We recognise that attending school regularly and punctually is vital to the educational process and encourages a good pattern of work. **Children only get one chance at school, and your child's chances of a successful future may be affected by not attending school regularly.**

Breakfast club-Doors are open between 8.10-8.30am

School hours for Year 3-6 are: 8.50-3.10pm

All pupils are expected to be on the school premises by 8.40.

The school is not responsible for pupils that arrive at school before 8.30am and are not members of the breakfast club as there is no adult supervision on the front yard.

Punctuality - **The school day begins at 8.40am**—any child arriving after this will receive a late mark. You will need to come to the main Reception and sign your child in.

All parents are expected to collect their child on time at the end of the school day. No children will be allowed to leave early except in cases where the child has a doctor's appointment for example. You will need to come to the main Reception to sign your child out.

Absence due to illness - It is imperative that parents provide an explanation on **the first day** your child is absent. You are requested to notify the school **before 9.20am**. Unless we receive a telephone call or a visit from the parent, then your child's absence will be registered as unauthorised.

School uniform



Pupils are encouraged to wear the school's official uniform. Also, appropriate clothes and footwear are essential for Physical Education lessons. Pupils are required to dress in these clothes on the day of their lesson. Denim jeans and clothes bearing commercial slogans and logos are not acceptable as school uniform. There are however several opportunities during the year to "dress down" on designated days (For example, "Children in Need").

We urge you to write your child's name clearly on his/her clothes. Unless this is done identifying the owners of any lost property is very difficult.

Medication



It is not expected of any member of staff to arrange or to administer any medicines for children in school. However, circumstances may arise where children are well enough to attend school having been prescribed medicine by their GP.



In cases such as this, parents must contact the school and complete a consent form enabling members of staff to administer prescribed medicines. Where possible, parents should ask their GP to prescribe medicine for their child that does not require the administration of any dosage during the school day. School staff **cannot** administer medicines that have not been prescribed by a doctor.
